The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education ensures that mediation is available, at no cost, to allow parents and school districts the opportunity to resolve disagreements involving any matter under Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

The mediation process is voluntary on the part of both parties. If both parties agree to mediation they will need to mutually agree upon a mediator from a list of qualified mediators provided by the Department.
