Marshall: So anything that you would particularly like to say before we're done?

Kacey: I would just like to say that, first of all, I appreciate CADRE and the work you do so much. You and I had talked a little bit before about overseeing three different systems and how that doesn't seem to be very common. And I do think that there is something to be said for that. If your state gets the number of disputes that we get, a manageable number, I think there is a lot of benefit of having one person oversee the three processes because it gives you a really good perspective about how they are different, how each the complaint process, mediation process and the due process system, can be used to achieve the result that the family is looking for. So I would encourage other states if they have that opportunity to have one person who can really see the big picture.
