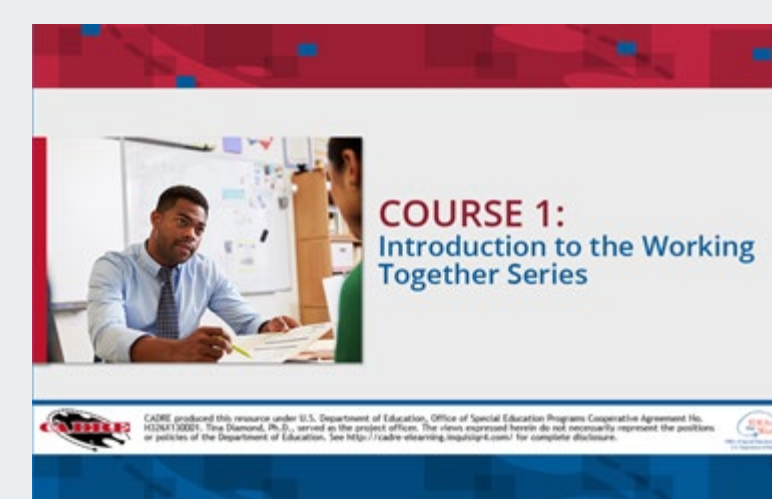
Steps to Success: Communicating with Your Child's School

Includes five interactive self-directed courses, providing families and educators with a number of strategies for working together and through conflict.

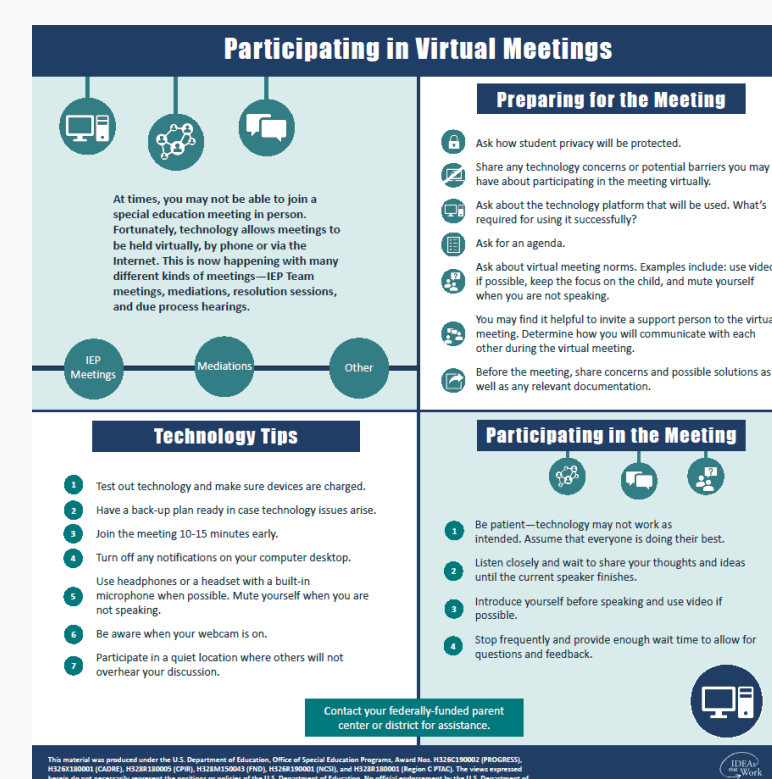
